Youth to Youth Club Agreement General Rules and Information:

- 1. All Participants and their parent/guardian must read and sign this agreement.
- 2. Participants must stay in designated areas directed by Youth to Youth staff.
- 3. No disrespectful, rude or profane language will be tolerated during the trip.
- 4. No use of alcohol, cigarettes, and/or drugs of any kind will be tolerated.
- 5. Participants must be prepared to leave Middlebrook at the scheduled departure time of 9:00AM. Any participant not at the school departure site on time will forfeit the entire trip fee.
- 6. All students will be required to check in with Youth to Youth coordinators (Tanya Leonard or Heather Schlitz) in designated areas at designated times. This is so that all students can be accounted for and/or in the event that we have to leave early.
- 7. All students **SHOULD** bring money or bagged lunch when noted. The first day of the week we will be making pizza and providing lunch. We will email participants and families prior to the days events. **Youth to Youth is not responsible for lost or stolen items.**
- 8. Dress appropriately for summer outdoor activities (bathing suits and towels may be needed). Participants and families will be notified prior to the days events when change of clothes may be needed.
- 9. The trip is scheduled to return to Middlebrook at designated times listed on the event calendar.
- 10. We will depart from and return to the Middlebrook School back parking lot (drop-off area). Friday drop off and pick up will be at Cranbury Park in Norwalk.
- 11. Any participant violating any of the above rules and regulations, or abusing any program privileges is subject to immediate dismissal from the program. Parent/guardian will be informed in case of dismissal from the program.

To Find Out If a Trip is Returning on Time:

If, for any reason, our return home will be 15 minutes or later past the scheduled return time a message will be posted on the Wilton Youth Council Facebook page. To Find Out if a Trip event has been moved due to Weather:
